- Collage The layering of fragments of externally referenced meaning from the past and the present that re-casts narratives, juxtaposing the ordinary with the incongruous to create a new whole.
- Under the curation of Ric Kidini Kashour, New Orleans, (Curatorial Fellowship 2021 Andy Warhol Institute for the Arts) and with the support of the Birr Historical Society, 16 collage artists from across the world will research, discuss, investigate and respond to the Cumberland Pillar in Emmet Square Birr, its history, and contemporary issues relating to place, context and colonial past. The selection will be diverse in terms of geography, nationality, gender, and race, to include artists representative of the minority Eastern European communities of Birr.
- The works will form an outdoor trail, printed on A1 boards, with audio guide taken from an online artists talk.
- While these artists are responding from without to this architectural feature in Birr, and how that resonates with their own lives, the second strand will ask the community from within the location to respond to the same theme. This response may or may not be paper collage, it could be a layering and repurposing of different art form such as film, music..

## Community window trail










- Families, businesses and community groups decorate their windows to make a dusk to dark window trail, guided by an online map.

# **Augmented Reality Trail**








- Curated trail of site specific artist's animations that use AR to create interventions with the fabric of the town.


